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Lourdes captures national rowing title

Victory for girls junior four boat is first in history of the program

It was the perfect ending to a historic season.

The Our Lady of Lourdes High School girls junior four boat captured the program's first national championship by winning the cholastic Rowing Nationals in uratoga Springs on Saturday. Ioanna Mulvey, Katie Roach, Liz iacou, Katie Coffin and coxswain

Kaitlyn Albrecht completed the 1,500meter course on Fish Creek in a time of 5 minutes, 57.05 seconds. Pine Crest was second in 6:06.81.

"It was just absolutely amazing to see them row this whole season," Lourdes coach Erik Haight

"The girls did make it look easy. All the work they put into it all year long was hard. They are a strong crew and they won by open water in the heat, semifinal and final. It was a phenomenal performance this weekend. They peaked on the right weekend - that's for sure."

"They were determined to hit No those goals. The state championships were on the same weekend be as the junior prom.


"My juniors skipped the prom so it would not impact their performance at states. It paid off because they won and qualified for nation-

WHO IS LOURDES CREW?

Lourdes Crew comprises the young men and women who row for the scholastic rowing team representing OLL

WHO IS LRA?

- ► Lourdes Rowing Association is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation that is responsible for funding and promoting the sport of rowing at OLL
- LRA is run by an elected and appointed board of directors
- Parents of rowers are members of the association





WHO CAN ROW?

- Lourdes Crew is open to all students who attend OLL.
- No experience or tryouts are needed
- BUT, you must pass a swim test
- AND, pay registration fees and associated costs. OLL does not fund the entirety of the sport.

WHAT IS ROWING?


- The act of propelling a boat my means of holding one oar, in a sweeping manner
- ► As a sport: it involves watercraft, called shells
- ► Lourdes Crew races 4+ and 8+

WHAT IS SCULLING?

- ► The act of propelling a boat by means of holding two oars (2x)
- ► As a sport: it involves watercraft, called sculls
- ► Lourdes Crew does not race sculls (1x, 2x, 4x)

WHAT DO NOVICES DO?

- Novice rowers must first pass the swim test, learn the parts of the boat, the motion and technique of the movements, how to lift and carry the boat, learn front/back/left/right and do it backwards, learn to row in the tanks, and erg...
- JV and Varsity already know all that stuff, they just work harder to row faster





WHAT IS AN ERG?

- Your new best friend
- a.k.a. Rowing machine
- You will learn the proper technique and names of each stage of the stroke movement on it
- This will also give you times, stroke rates, etc.

WHAT ARE TANKS?

- Novices start rowing in the indoor tanks at the boathouse
- The tanks are stationary "boats" with the same sliding mechanics as shells, so you won't be going anywhere, BUT you are one step closer to rowing on the water!






WHY ROW?

WHERE DO YOU LEARN TO ROW?


- Lourdes Crew operates out of the Hudson River Rowing
 Association (HRRA) boathouse on Water St. in Poughkeepsie
- HRRA offers Learn-to-Row, junior, and adult programs to people of all ages in the Spring, Summer, and Fall months.



WHERE DO YOU RACE?

- Novices race here on the Hudson River and they may have an away regatta in Saratoga. Regattas in Saratoga are on Fish Creek at the NYS boat launch.
- JV/V races may be in Saratoga, Philadelphia, Rochester, and the Hudson Valley.






WHEN DOES PRACTICE HAPPEN?

- Novice crew will begin instruction five days/week after school at the boathouse. This begins when weather is warmer and water is row-able. If scheduling allows earlier tank availability, it may begin with three days/week.
- When season starts, there may be occasional Saturday and/or weekday mornings; Spring Break excluding holy days and Easter Monday.

HOW DO YOU JOIN?

- Sign up today by providing us with your names, emails, numbers
- An email will follow with paperwork, instructions, and waivers. LRA will be making forms available on the website: https://www.ollchs.org/athletics/lourdes-rowing-association
- Deposits will be taken, and balances must be paid in full by March 15th.





HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- Novice Crew registration for 2022 is \$700
- Lodging and food for any away regattas will be the responsibility of the parents/ guardians of each rower. LRA works to secure hotel room blocks/rates when there may be overnight stays.
- Fees cover only a portion of the actual cost to row, and fundraising is an essential part of the LRA duties.
